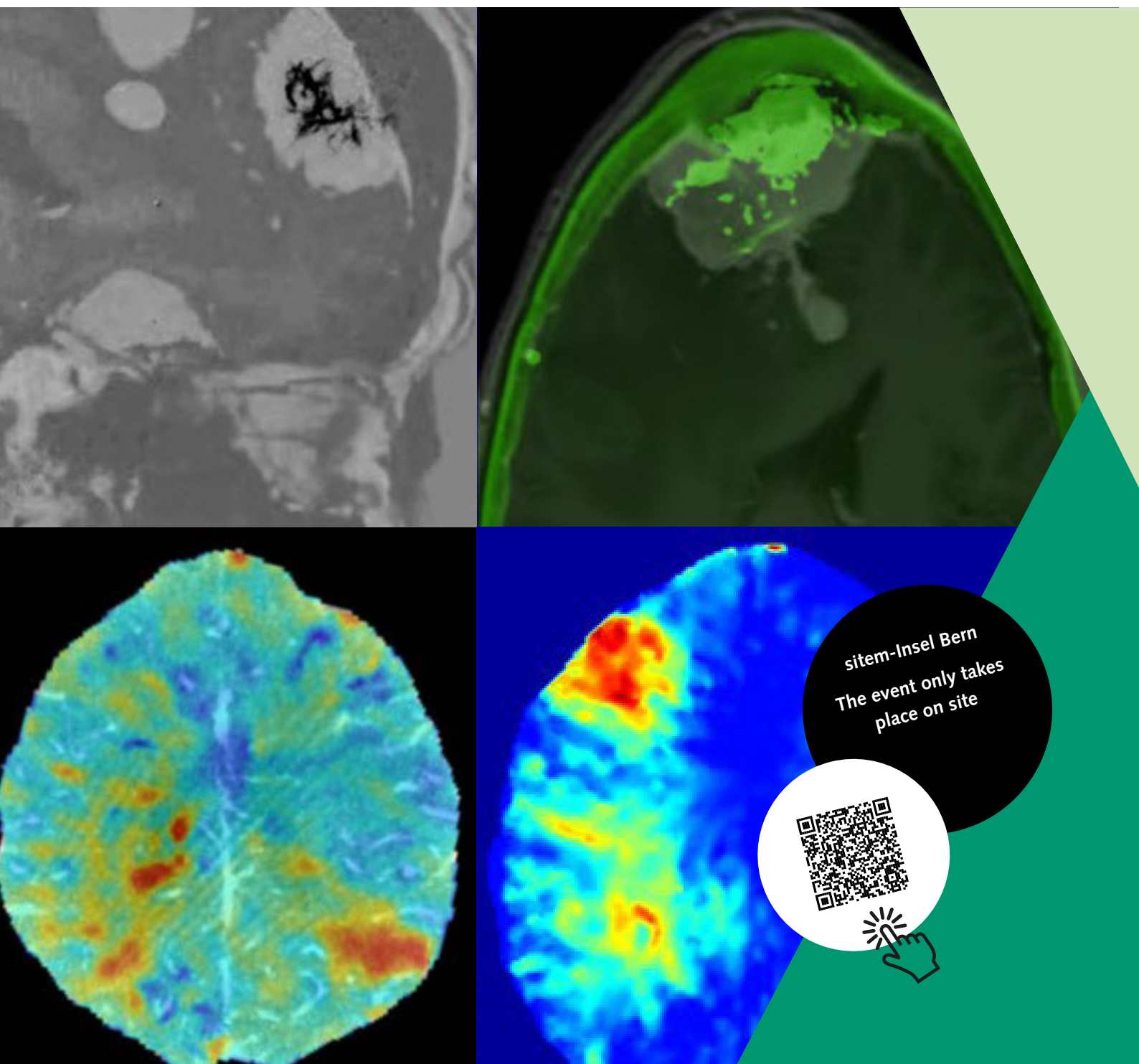

# Flat-Panel Advanced peri-operative Imaging in the angio suite:

## *We can only treat what we see*

Recent advances in intraoperative diagnostic flat-panel imaging, particularly the advent of high-resolution, time-resolved 3D imaging, perfusion acquisitions, fusion imaging with other modalities and live overlays have provided physicians with complex yet valuable additional information. As with any new technology, effective acquisition, detection, and interpretation of the findings require experience and a solid evidence-based foundation. However, many of the techniques presented are not yet widely adopted. Implementing new techniques without a strong evidence-based foundation may lead to misinterpretation and slow the adoption of an otherwise beneficial modality. To prevent this and in order to gain momentum for this new development, the scientific goal of the congress is to bring together leading researchers in this emerging field, train physicians to adopt and utilize the new imaging modality, and outline future research in collaboration with industry partners. After a successful first edition in 2025 (Tours, France), the organizing committee welcomes you in cozy Bern just when Winter is about to start. We look forward to welcoming you to a stimulating and enriching event.

### Target audience

This meeting is dedicated to neurointerventionalists of all backgrounds seeking to advance knowledge and clinical practice in advanced perioperative diagnostic imaging for minimally invasive neurological treatment. It will bring together neurologists, neurosurgeons, and neuroradiologists from around the world who share an interest in this challenging and rapidly developing field.

The program will provide a theoretical background as well as practical knowledge, with several hands-on

workshops focusing on the direct applicability of the taught subjects. With this combination of both, participants are encouraged to directly implement new techniques and findings into their clinics and clinical routine when returning from Bern.
